## Prevent Ice Dams.

An ice dam is what happens when thawing snow from your roof refreezes at the edge of your roof and in your gutters. This ice prevents thawing water to leave the roof and potentially go back up the roof and run under the shingles. The way to prevent this from happening is to either stop the melting or keep the water thawed. To stop the melting you have to limit the amount of heat that leaves the interior of your home into the attic with air sealing and insulation. To keep the water flowing off of your roof you need to keep your gutters clean and possibly run a heated ice melting wire at the edge for your roof and through your gutters. ## Ask the Experts

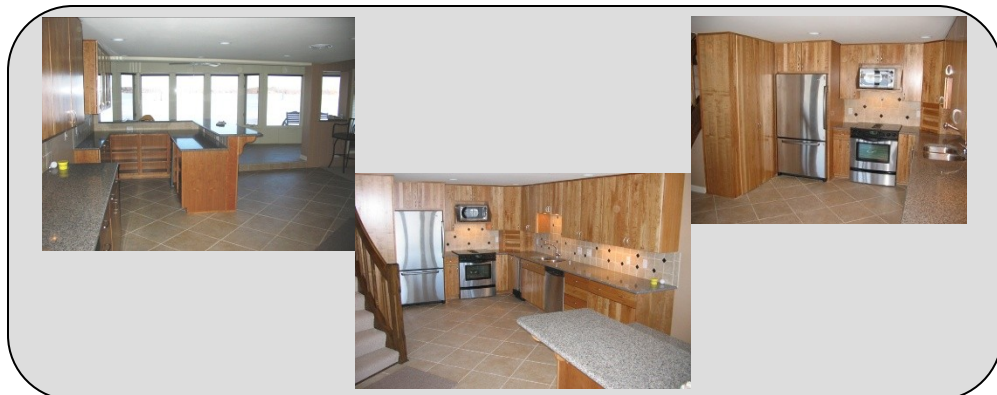
Q: How do you claim the federal energy tax credit?
